

CHRIST LOVE FOUNDATION (INC.) ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2013.

INTRODUCTION: I am pleased to present the Annual Report of Christ Love Foundation Inc. for year 2013. Thank God for His faithfulness to us in the year. The Foundation has continued to make observable growth both in terms of income and in the spread and impact of its activities. Below are the details of the activities of the Foundation during the year.

EDUCATION: We provided education financial support for a total of 41 students in both primary and secondary schools located in Lagos, Ogun, Oyo, Ondo and Ekiti states of Nigeria during the year. We expended the sum of N436,850 on educational grants/sponsorship and financial assistance.

MISSION WORK: As in previous years, we supported missionaries in their efforts to reach souls in remote places. We gave financial, moral and material support for mission work in Eastern and Western parts of Nigeria. We also gave regular financial assistance to four missionaries operating in Niger Republic. In all, the Foundation spent a total of N129,500 on mission support last year. In addition, we made it a duty to always pray for missionaries across the world in our weekly prayer meetings.

WIDOWS: We have always considered support for widows an important part of our assignment. For this reason, we regularly pray for them and support them with money. The foundation spent N29,000 to support this category of people last year.

GENERAL HELP: As usual, we assisted different categories of people who needed one form of assistance or the other. This took the sum of N189,000.

ASSISTANCE TO START SMALL SCALE BUSINESS: Some people were assisted with money to start small business or to enhance an already existing business. For example, the Foundation bought a Drier for a hairdresser, sewing machine for a tailor, gave money to someone to start selling provisions, and another person got money to start selling food. The amount spent on all these was N63,000.

OUTREACHES: Our outreach programme which began in 2009 was intensified with the Foundation's activities spreading to new areas. In 2013, we held meetings in Ilogbo-Ekiti in Ekiti State, Akure and Ikare-Akoko in Ondo State and Aba Nla in Oyo State. Christ Love Foundation outreaches gulped the sum of N173,500 last year. We are happy to report that many of the ministers who participated in CLF outreaches last year have called or sent text messages to say that the meetings blessed them exceedingly.

PLANS FOR 2014:

1. We plan to consolidate on the gains of the previous years. We shall continue to raise awareness about the activities of the Foundation through the vision-

sharing meetings and other avenues. Plans are on to hold outreach in Ibadan, Abeokuta, Iwo and Kogi State.

2. We plan to expand our ministry to the widows. Apart from just giving financial assistance, we plan to hold sessions with them during our outreaches. This is to challenge young widows to rise up and take their place in God. We shall continue to do whatever is within our power to help them financially. The important thing is to let them know that widowhood is not the end of life. In God, they can pick up their lives again and live a fulfilled life.

3. We shall strive to expansion of our education support/sponsorship scheme. We plan to bring more children of ministers of the gospel on board of the scheme because they are our primary target. Of course, other indigent but promising children in public primary and secondary schools especially in states where Christ Love Foundation does not presently have a presence, will also be brought on board.
