

**CHRIST LOVE FOUNDATION (INC.)
ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2014**

Introduction

We thank God for the end of another year. We have continued to enjoy God's faithfulness as we travelled across the land ministering to the needs of God's people and others who are not even Christians. We also enjoyed His goodness in the provision of financial resources to carry out the activities of the Foundation.

Meetings in Ibadan, Iludun-Ekiti, Ijero-Ekiti and Aramoko-Ekiti

We had special meetings in the above-mentioned locations in 2014. The Ibadan meeting took place on the 22nd of March and had in attendance many people. They included thirty-two (32) gospel ministers and one hundred and thirty (130) church members. The next Christ Love Foundation meeting was held on the 19th of April, 2014 in Ekiti State in the town of Iludun-Ekiti. There were forty-three (43) ministers of God in attendance in addition to many other church members. At this meeting we distributed used but good clothes to the needy and also gave monetary gifts to the widows.

In June, we moved to Ijero-Ekiti also in Ekiti State. Here again we shared God's word with a congregation that had twenty-three (23) ministers of God and many church members. We ministered to ten (10) widows at the meeting.

The last meeting for the year 2014 took place on 3rd of October, in Aramoko-Ekiti. In attendance we had forty-one (41) gospel ministers and many other people numbering one hundred and seven thousand (107).

After sharing God's word with the people, we gave gift of raw rice to the widows while we explained to the ministers how they and their members could benefit from the activities of Christ Love Foundation.

Normally at our meetings, we have three sessions

The value of organizing these four (4) outreaches amounted to **N367,800**. This included the cost of making the CLF T-shirts usually given as souvenirs at our meetings.

Education Support/Sponsorship Scheme

In 2014, we had 25 children on our education support scheme. The school fees of the children on the scheme were paid either partially or fully. The foundation also gave allowances for the purchase of books. The total money expended on the Education scheme in 2014 was **N466,850**.

Ministering To Widows

During the outreach programmes of 2014, many widows received material assistance in terms of food and clothes, while few got financial assistance. The total spent on widows in 2014 was N46,000.

General Help to the Poor and Needy

We had many people who applied for financial assistance to start petty business or for medical treatment. During the year, we were able to assist twenty-four (24) people in this regard. We encouraged people to explore the possibility of getting loans from micro-finance banks. The amount on general assistance was N294,000.

Support for Missions

The Foundation supported eight (8) missionaries in 2014; we gave direct financial assistance to some of these missionaries. We are grateful to Bro.Mike Okuneye of World Alive Ministry Int., Kaduna for helping to facilitate this. The amount expended in this direction was N78,000.

Caring and Sharing

This has remained a cardinal aspect of our work. In all our meetings, we distributed used but good clothes and accessories such as hats, shoes etc to the needy. As led by God's spirit, we have also consistently assisted the poor and the needy through direct financial assistance for food and other needs.
